The Sani Pass Route follows the foot of the magnificent Drakensberg Mountain Range with spectacular views over the entire length of the route (319 km). Breakfast can be had at various establishments on the way to and at Nottingham Road such as Piggly Wiggly, Rawdons (Nottingham Road Brewery), Der Bierfassl, Nottingham Road Hotel.

The route tracks the foothills of the Drakensberg Mountains, and the scenery is fantastic (keep your eyes on the winding road and stop to admire the scenery!) Read more at <http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Drakensberg>

The planned route is a mixture of tar and dirt roads with some really fantastic gravel passes; stunning mountain scenery and the famous Underberg Hotel and the Himeville Arms (proposed lunch venues) should make this a very popular route. A 'must see' is the Nzinga River Falls, and a Waypoint for this spectacle has been loaded with the route.
